Step 1

On your Windows 2000 desktop, click on **Start**, then click on **Settings**, then click on **Network and Dialup Connections.**



Step 2

Inside of Network and Dial-Up Connections window, find the icon labeled **Make New Connection** and **double-click** on it.

Step 5

First, make sure that the checkbox that reads 'use dialing rules' is <u>not checked</u>. Next, type in one of our dial-up access phone numbers into the blank labeled 'Phone number'.

Now, we need to modify some of the dial-up settings. **Right-click** on the new ACCS icon, then **left-click** on '**Properties**'.

Now, **left-click** on the item that reads 'Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)' so it is highlighted as shown. Then, **left-click** on the button that reads '**Properties**'.

Step 11

This is where we will be entering our DNS information. First, **left-click** on the button that reads 'Use the following DNS server addresses'. Then type in the two DNS numbers into the Preferred and Alternate DNS blanks so that your box looks like the one shown.

Step 12

Lastly, close the 'Networking Connections' window and go back to the desktop. On the desktop, you should now see an icon labeled 'ACCS'. To connect to the internet, **double-click** on the ACCS icon. This window should appear. Simply type in your ACCS username into the 'username' blank and type in your ACCS password into the 'password' blank. Once this is done, **check** the 'Save Password' box. Now, **left-click** on the '**Dial**' button and your computer will dial into the internet.
